- Serve as first point of contact for the regulator and act as the registered Compliance Officer towards the CSSF
- Ensure funds are compliant with local regulations and adhere to relevant laws
- Review, disseminate, and interpret relevant laws and regulations and work to proactively establish and document related policies, procedures and standards
- Identify situations which pose significant compliance risk and guide management in developing policies and/or procedures that minimize that risk
- Preparing reports for the group and the local management
- Act as permanent Compliance Officer function AML/CFT and Money Laundering Reporting Officer (MLRO)
- Act as "Responsable du contrôle" (RC) for our funds and towards the CSSF
- Alignment and Implementation of internal group rules with local requirements
- Interact with regulators, internal and external auditors on regulatory topics
- Serve as a point of contact with business partners and investors
- Contribute to the corporate organization
